The Governments of the United States of America and the Philippines welcome senior government officials, industry executives, and other stakeholders to the 6th Indo-Pacific Business Forum. The event will feature expert panels, business matchmaking, and the opportunity to connect with private sector and senior government decision-makers from across the Indo-Pacific.

BACKGROUND

The U.S. Trade and Development Agency (USTDA) and the Government of the Philippines will co-host the 6th IPBF in Manila, Philippines, in partnership with the U.S. Department of State. The IPBF is the premier public-private U.S. government event to promote trade, investment, and economic cooperation between the United States and its partners throughout the Indo-Pacific region.

This year's IPBF will build upon the success of the previous five forums that have brought together more than 8,500 participants from 67 countries. The event connects government/industry and international partners to share knowledge, identify export opportunities in emerging Indo-Pacific economies, and help partners find infrastructure solutions for development challenges. The event is also a chance to learn more about government tools and programs to support projects in the region, including key decision-makers from both the U.S. and the Philippines.

The in-person event will bring together 500 attendees from across the region to participate. The event will be complimented with a virtual livestream for maximum regional participation.
